The Spirit's Work and Witness

The Holy Spirit is the most intimate of the members of the Holy Trinity. He's the one who actually touches us personally; he is the one who comes into our lives personally.

I want to ask you this morning about the condition of your life, deep down inside where the Holy Spirit

comes to dwell

- Are you fulfilled?
- Are you growing?
- Are you peaceful?
 - Are you stuck?
- Are you defeated down there; are you discouraged?

I want to ask you this morning about the condition of your life, deep down inside where the Holy Spirit comes to dwell

- Are you joyful, invigorated, vital?
- Are you one day up, another day down?
 - Are you empty; is there pain there?
- Do you experience intimacy with God?
 - Is there something dynamic occurring through a real sense of the reality of God in your life?

I want to ask you this morning about the condition of your life, deep down inside where the Holy Spirit comes to dwell

- Do you pray out of duty or out of desire?
- Do you sense deeply the inner peace of God, or is there pain in your inner person?
- Are you struggling in your spirit; are you guilty?
 - Are you locked up?
 - Are you critical?
 - Are you sort of moralistic?
 - Are you alone?

I want to ask you this morning about the condition of your life, deep down inside where the Holy Spirit comes to dwell

- Or, when you slow down and reflect on who you are and who God really is, is there inner joy?
- Is there inner peace and an overriding gratitude to the Lord that's bigger than your momentary pain and disappointment?

Jesus said:

“Peace. I am giving you peace.”

Pentecost is a Greek word that means "fifty."
The day was called that because it was fifty days after the Passover feast. Pentecost meant a Jewish feast which is given to us in the Old Testament under the title, the Feast of Weeks, i.e., seven weeks were to be numbered from Passover, or forty-nine days; then on the fiftieth day they were to have the Feast of Weeks,

It is called also the Feast of the Wave Loaves because it consisted of two loaves of bread that were baked of grain from the new harvest.

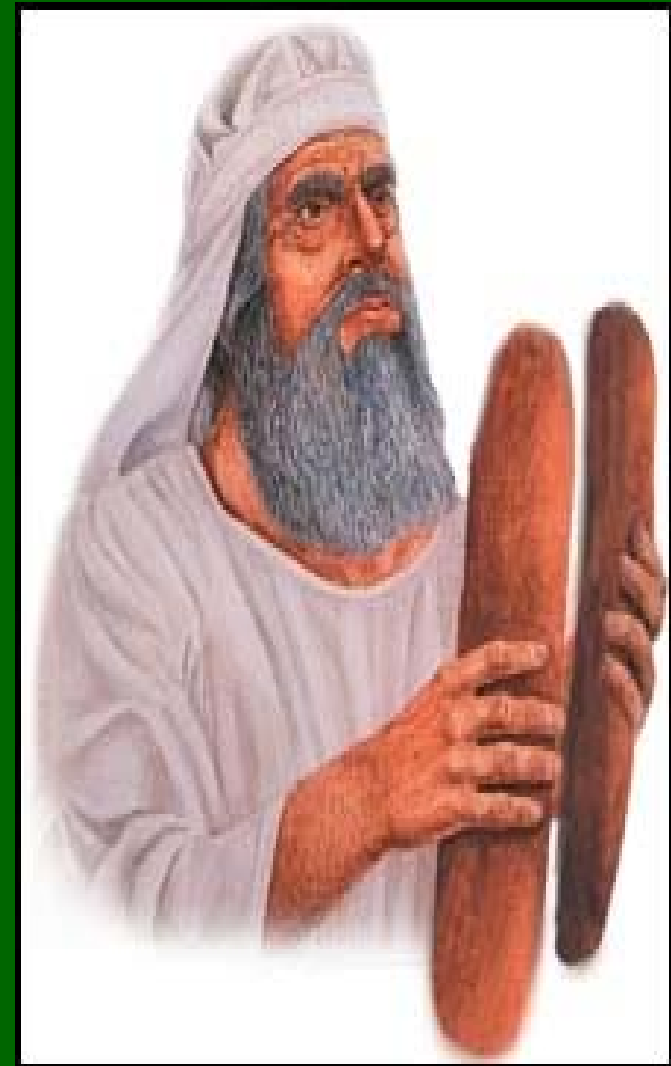
15 Seven weeks after you offer this bundle of grain, each family must bring another offering of new grain. **16** Do this exactly fifty days later, which is the day following the seventh Sabbath. **17** Bring two loaves of bread to be lifted up in dedication to me. Each loaf is to be made with yeast and with four pounds of the finest flour from the first part of your harvest. (Lev 23:15)



- These two loaves were symbols of the two bodies from which the church was to be formed: the Jews and the Gentiles.
- Jesus said he came first to the lost sheep of the house of the Israel, the Jews.



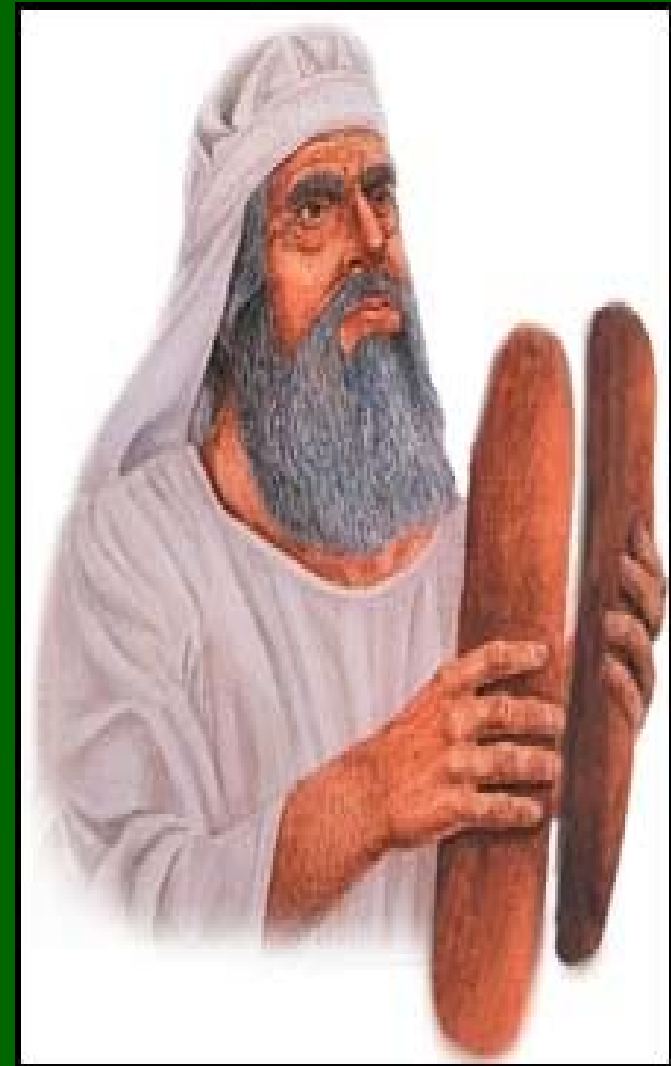
- But he said, "Other sheep have I which are not of this fold; them also must I bring that there may be one flock," John 10:16).



- He was referring to the Gentiles. Here, on the day of Pentecost, God took the Jews and the Gentiles and brought them together and baptized them into one.



- The wave loaves is the only sacrifice in all the Old Testament that ever had leaven included in it. Why?
- Well, it is God's wonderful way of telling us that the church is not made up of perfect people. It is made up of saints, but they are sinful saints. They yet have sin in them.

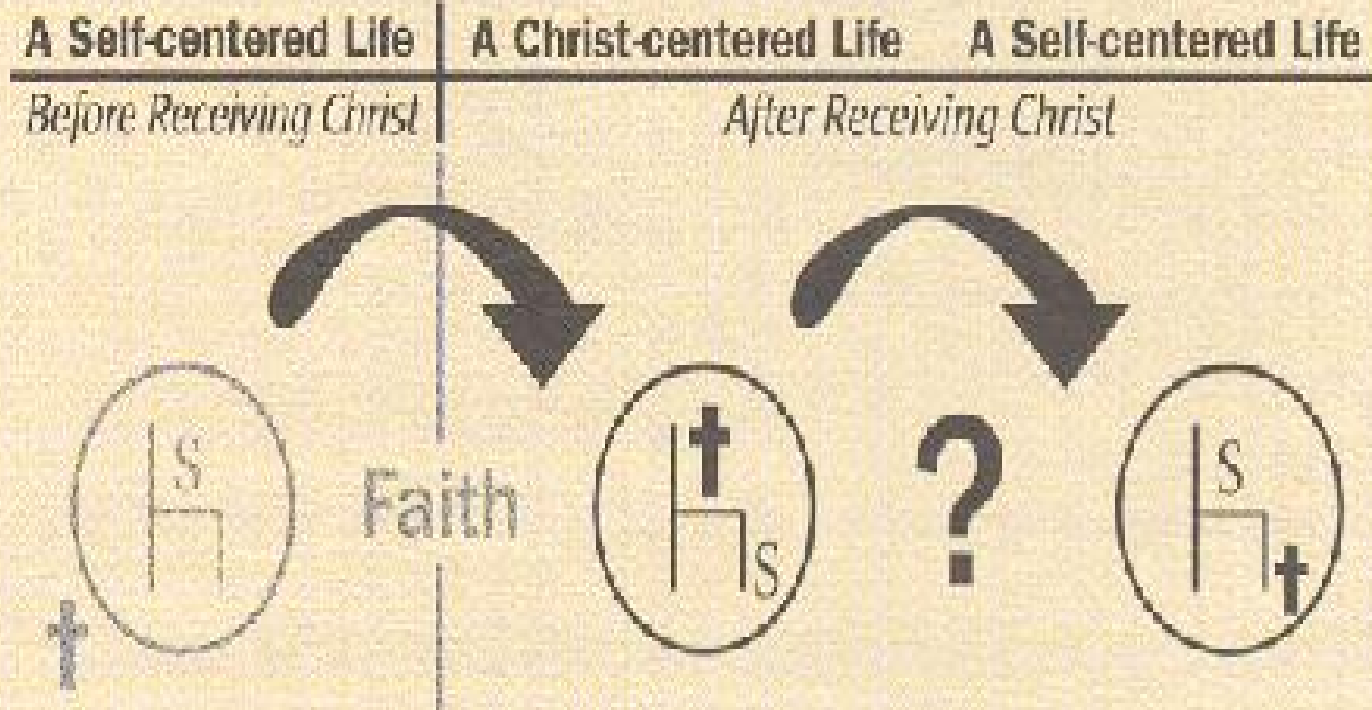
You cannot be a little Jesus apart from the indwelling presence of the Holy Spirit working in you.

Paul says to the Christians in Galatia

“Are you so foolish after beginning with the Holy Spirit, are you now trying to attain your goal by human effort?”

“The sinful nature desires what is contrary to the Spirit and the Spirit desires what is contrary to the sinful nature. They are in conflict with each other so that you do not do what you want until you learn to walk in the Spirit.”

To these Paul says in 1 Corinthians 3

“Brothers and sisters, I couldn’t address you as spiritual but as worldly, mere infants in Christ. I gave you milk, not solid food, for you are not ready for it. Indeed, you are still not ready. You are still worldly, [even though they were Christians.] You are worldly, since there is jealousy and quarreling among you. Are you not worldly? Are you not acting like mere men even though you have the Holy Spirit?”

Knowing that:

- The Holy Spirit is the Divine Gift
 - There is a Present Danger
 - We then learn to:
 - Walk in the Spirit

Well, how do we get to this place?

It is learning to depend upon the Holy Spirit and his abundant resources as a way of life.

It's not going through life saying,

“I will be loving.

I will be good.

I will obey God.”

That's just depending on your own willpower.

**You are going
to fail.**

It's as we depend upon the Holy Spirit that we have the ability to live a life that is pleasing to God.

- Paul says in Galatians 5:
- “16 So I say, live by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the sinful nature. 25 Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit.”

All right, then, how can I be sure
that I am on this journey?

“Most merciful God, I confess that I have
sinned against you in thought, word and
deed by what I have done and by what I
haven’t done. I haven’t loved you with my
whole heart. I haven’t loved my neighbors
as myself. Please forgive me.”

All right, then, how can I be sure
that I am on this journey?

“Lord, I open the door of my life and I ask
you take control of me, my will, my wants,
my emotions, my relationships. Please fill
every part of me with your Holy Spirit.
Please help me become the person you
want me to be.”

- Of course, there are other things that make a huge difference in our relationship with the Lord.
- meeting regularly with other believers for honest discussion and prayer and worship;
 - having models and mentors to follow;
 - studying the Bible,

- learning to pray,
- learning about the gifts of the Holy Spirit;
 - serving God in the church;
 - serving God in the world
- all of these things make a big difference,

comes when I realize

I am not God.

spiritual breathing

I exhale when I realize when I am trying so hard to do what only God can do, or when I am trying to do what is displeasing to God.

I must get rid of that, I must exhale it.

“Take it away, God.”

I get rid of that attitude,

I inhale deeply receiving Christ's Spirit throughout my being again.

I ask him to fill me.

I give myself afresh to Christ.

I ask him to take this particular problem.

I ask him to take this relationship that I can't get worked out.

spiritual breathing

I ask him to take this dilemma and work in me and work in this other person and work in this situation and work on it, by the Holy Spirit, to work it out according to God's purposes.

I choose to rely upon the Holy Spirit.

I choose peace through trust in him.

So, you see, when you choose to
rely upon the Holy Spirit

He answers your prayer to fill you, and he
will be at work in that situation for his
purposes.

Second, God strengthens you with power
through his spirit in the inner person.

And third, God fills you with his Holy Spirit.
He takes whatever the situation is and he
takes control

When we know that the Holy Spirit is “the empowering presence”.

We understand that the essence of the Christian life is what God does in and through us, not what we do for God.

It is a huge, immense relief to
affirm:

I do not have to be God.

This then is the turning point in a Christian's
life, realizing that it is God who lives the
Christian life in us, through us, by the Holy
Spirit. We are filled with the Holy Spirit
simply by faith.

I started with some questions and it is this way by which I want to end:

Do you really want to experience intimacy with God?

Do you want God to have his way in your life?

Are you ready to give up trying to control your life and allow him to control it?

I started with some questions and it is this way by which I want to end:

Have you truly accepted that he's God and you are not? Have you really confessed your sins to God?

Have you received his forgiveness?

Have you opened up all areas of your life as best you know how, giving him unhindered access?

I started with some questions and it is this way by which I want to end:

Will you entrust your problems to him, even as you keep working to try to solve them?

Will you give them to him instead of holding them within yourself?
