Introduction to the Instructed Eucharist

Background of the word *Seder*

- Hebrew: *sedher*
- order, division

"With fervent desire I have desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer."

Luke 22:15

- This ceremony and celebration that had been commanded by God.
- Seder is the traditional Passover Week Dinner celebrated by the Hebrews since the Exodus. It is the Hebrew Thanksgiving, giving thanks to God for deliverance and redemption.

Luke 22:15

- Seder is also called the Passover Dinner, commemorating the protection of God as the Angel of Death passed over every family protected by the Blood of the Paschal Lamb.

- Seder is Bible Study. It is in this family setting that Jewish children were first introduced to the Book of Exodus as the adults gained further insight. We refer to this kind of instruction as multimedia, as all five senses are involved to make this study an unforgettable event.

Luke 22:15

- Seder is that famous Dinner called The Last Supper, hosted by Jesus for His disciples. Seder, as the setting for Jesus' Last Supper, was the event Jesus choose to announce The New Covenant. And it was at this Seder that Jesus asked all of us to *do this in remembrance of Him.*

Luke 22:15

- Seder was the basis of the early Church's Lord's Day worship service. It was referred to as the Agape Feast and Eucharist.
- Agape is the Greek word for Christian Love, that Love we have for one another.

- Eucharist is a transliteration of the Greek word which means to give thanks to God, implying that Thanksgiving is an obligation for the works of God.
