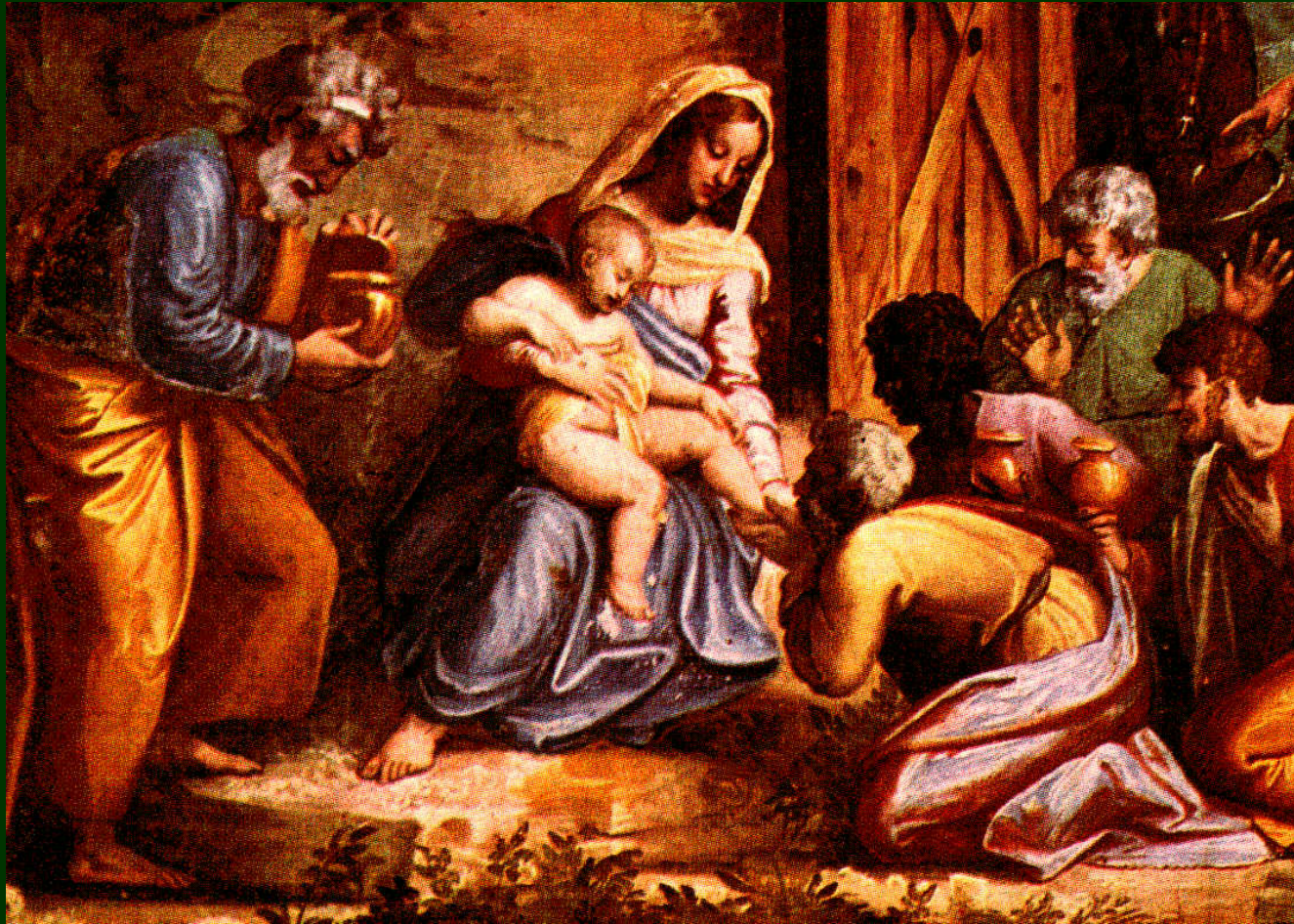

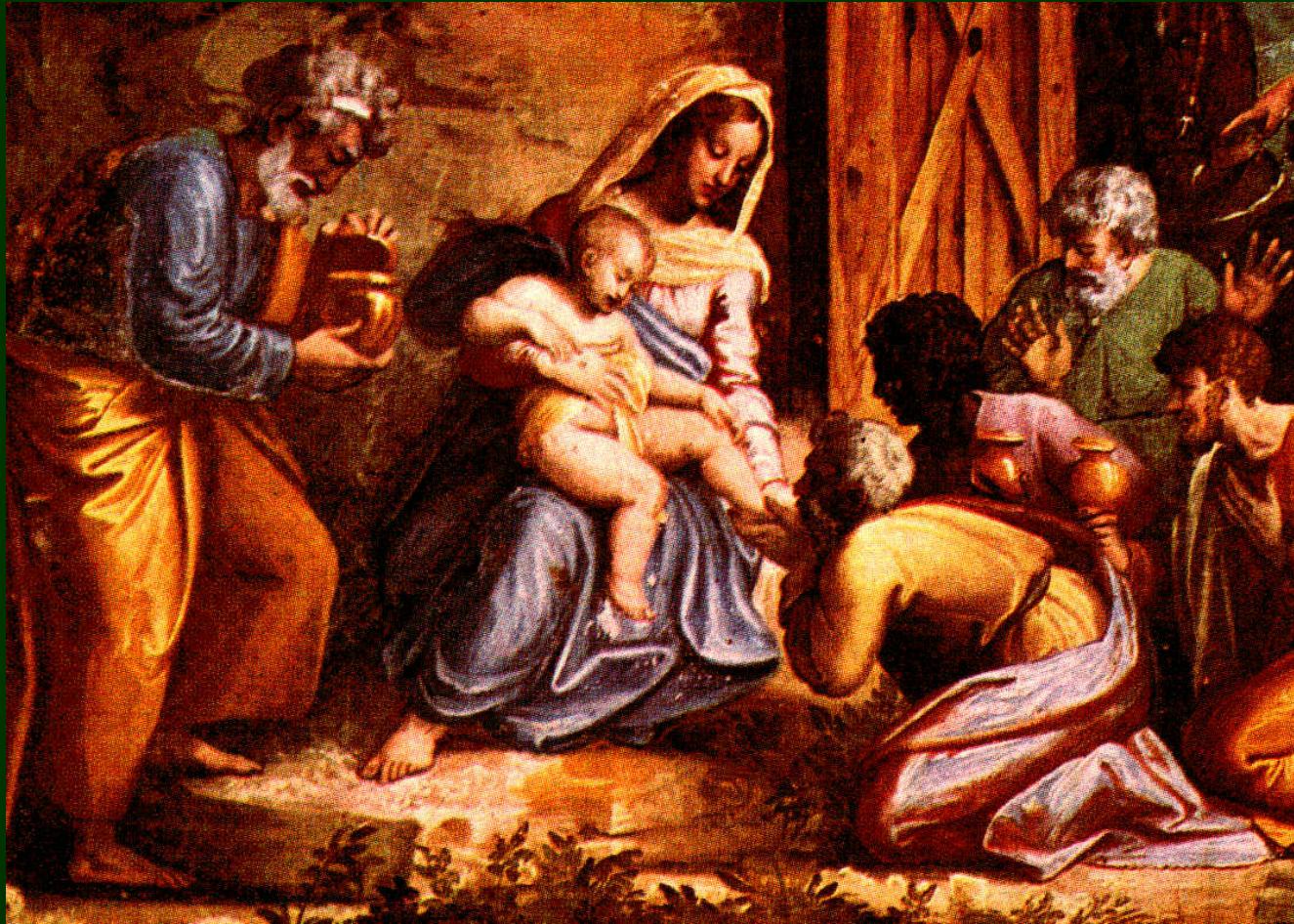

Christ,

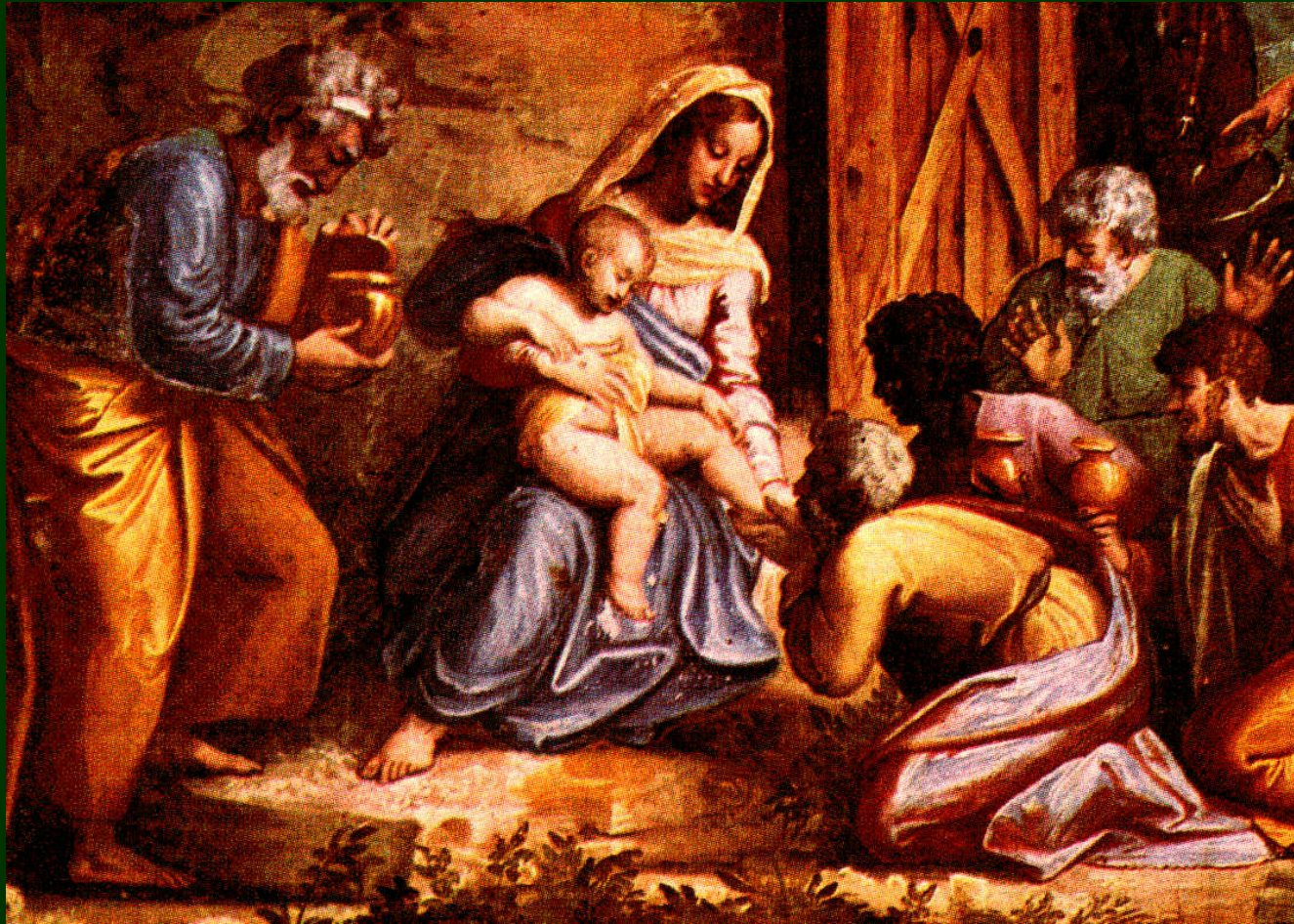
and we give you praise for all
