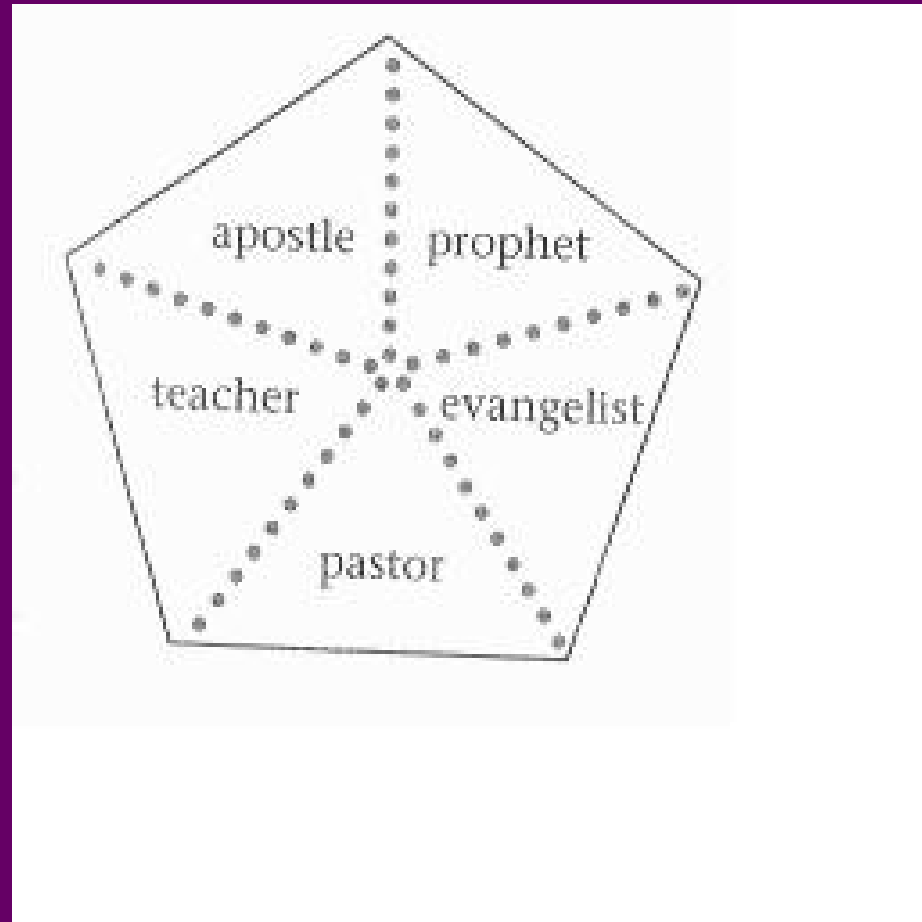

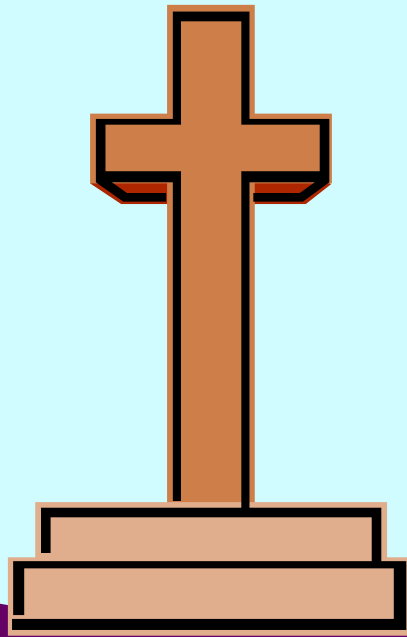

## The pentagon – five fold ministries

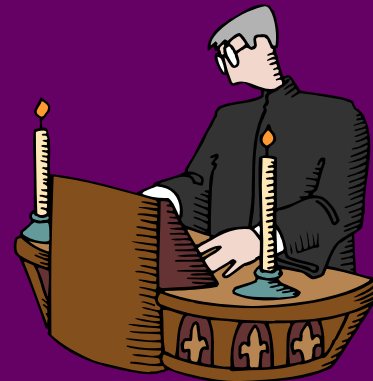

and their deeds.

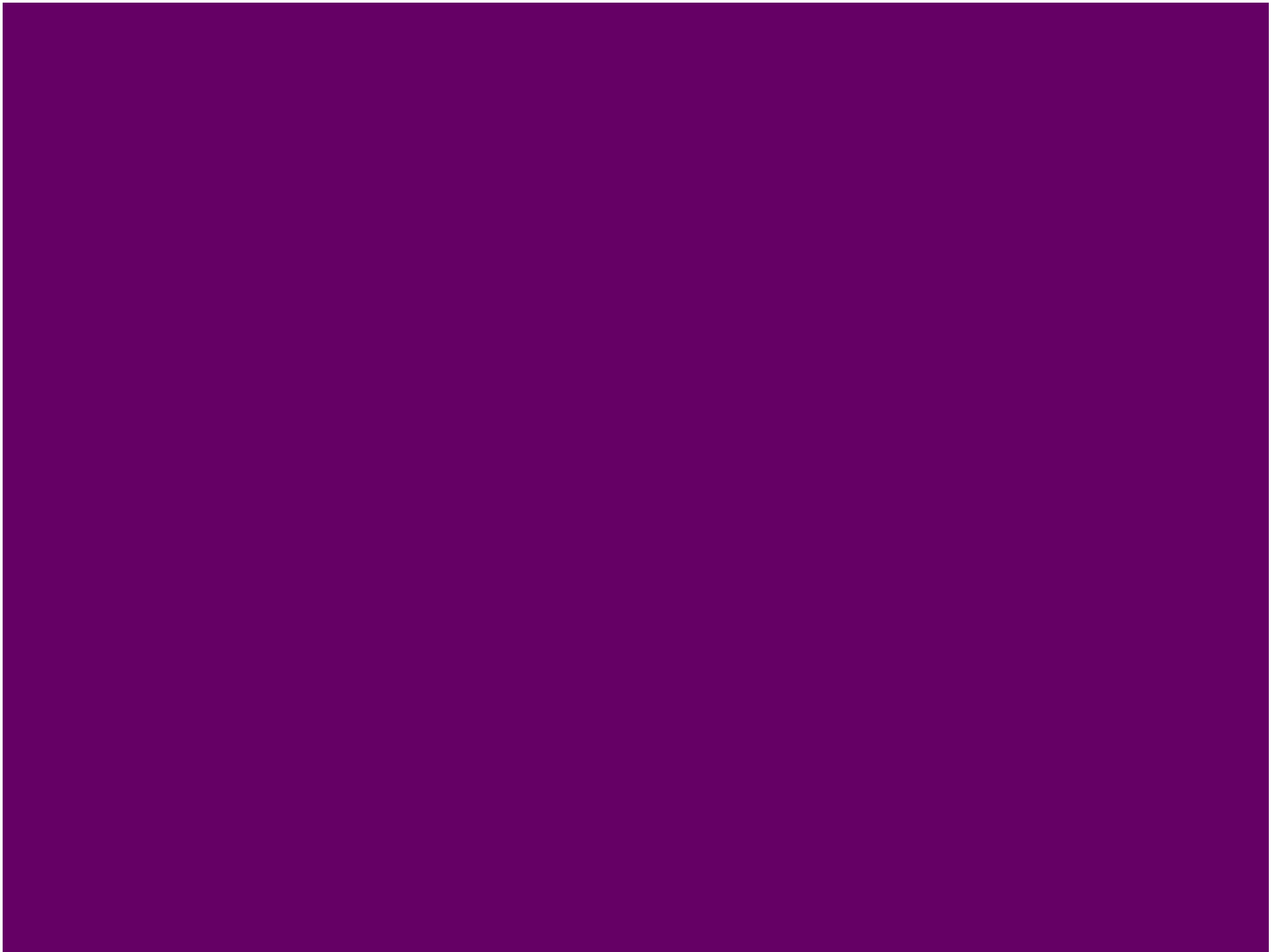
He has poured out His Holy Spirit upon us in abundance: the gift and guarantee of eternal life, who makes those who believe and obey children of God and joint heirs of Christ.
